1. The Government of Nepal [GoN] has allocated funds towards the cost of Construction of Four Lane RCC Box Girder Bridge over Mahakali River, Dodhara, Kanchanpur and intends to apply the funds to cover eligible payments under the Contract mentioned in the table below.

Department of Roads, Road Improvement Project invites sealed bids or electronic bids from eligible bidders for the construction of work under International Competitive Bidding (ICB), **Single stage Two Envelope Bidding procedures**. Bidding is open to all eligible Nepalese and Foreign Bidders. Detail qualification requirements for the bidder to qualify are fully described in the Bidding Documents.
3. Eligible Bidders may obtain further information and inspect the Bid Documents at the office of Department of Roads, Road Improvement Project, Ram Mandir Marga, Battisputali, Kathmandu. 4. A complete set of bidding documents may be purchased within office hour on or before **25th May 2017** from the office **Road Improvement Project, Ram Mandir Marga, Battisputali, Kathmandu** and from the office of **Foreign Cooperation Branch, Department of Roads, Jwagal, Lalitpur** by eligible Bidders on the submission of a written application, along with the copy of company/firm registration certificate, and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of as mentioned above. If so requested, the Bidding Documents can also be sent by post/courier services upon payment of additional cost of NRs. 20000.00 or in US\$200.00. However, the Project Office will not be responsible for delay or non-delivery of the documents so sent.

Bidders who choose to submit their bid electronically may purchase the hardcopy of the bidding documents as mentioned above or may download the bidding documents for e-submission from web-site of Department of Roads, i.e. <http://www.dor.gov.np>. Bidders, submitting their bid electronically, should deposit the cost (as specified above) of bidding document in the revenue (Rajaswa) account of the Road Improvement Project as specified below and the scanned copy (pdf format) of the Bank deposit voucher shall be uploaded by the bidder at the time of submission of their electronic bids.

5. Pre-bid meeting will be held at the time 11:00 hrs on date **14<sup>th</sup> June, 2017** at Project Office, **Ram Mandir Marga, Battisputali, Kathmandu**.
6. The technical Bid and Financial Bid shall be sealed in two separate envelopes and clearly marked as "Technical Bid" and "Financial Bid" and shall be sealed in a single envelope and marked as "Bid" in the form of Hard Copy and must be submitted to the Project Office (as mentioned in S.N.2) by hand/courier on or before **12:00 noon** on 26th May 2017. Similarly, electronic bids in the form of Technical Bid and Financial Bid must be submitted through [www.dor.gov.np](http://www.dor.gov.np) as mentioned in S.N. 4. Bids received after deadline will be rejected.
7. The **Technical Sealed Bids /e-submitted Bids** shall be opened in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend **at 13:00 hrs on 26<sup>th</sup> June, 2017** at the office of **Road Improvement Project, Project Coordination Unit, Ram Mandir Marga, Battisputali, Kathmandu**. Bids must be valid for a period of **120 Days** counting from the day of bid opening and must be accompanied by bid security, amounting to above mentioned amount in the table under SN. 1, which shall be **valid for minimum 30 days** beyond the bid validity period.
8. If bidder wishes to submit the Bid Security in the form of NRs cash, the cash should be deposited in Retention Account No. **1201200001002524** of district treasury comptroller office, Kathmandu at Nepal Rastra Bank, Thapathali with indication of office code 27-337-55 and submit the original copy of the receipt of the deposited amount of cash along with the bid. If the bid security is issued by foreign bank, then it must be counter guaranteed by the commercial bank of Nepal.
9. Bidders are advised to visit site and assess the actual site conditions before submitting their bid.
10. If the last date of purchasing, submission and opening falls on a government holiday then the next working day shall be considered the last day. In such case the validity of Bid Security shall be considered from already specified last date for bid submission.
11. The Employer reserve/s the right to accept or reject, wholly or partly any or all the bids without assigning reason, whatsoever.
12. Any additional matters not covered by this invitation shall be in accordance with the prevailing Public Procurement Act, 2063 and Public Procurement Regulation, 2064 of the Government of Nepal (GoN).
13. The bidder who submitted bid electronically they should submit their hard copy of bid within seven days of opening the bid.
