- The Government of Nepal has received financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) towards the cost of Kathmandu Valley Wastewater Management Project. Part of this financing will be used for payments under the contract named above. Bidding is open to eligible bidders from eligible source countries of the ADB.
- The Project Implementation Directorate, KUKL ("the Employer") invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the Supply of Sewer Cleaning Equipment, which consist of major equipment as mentioned hereunder:
 - Jetting machine of 3500 liter capacity - 2 nos.
 - Rodding Machine of 6.5 hp engine - 2 Nos.
 - Suction machine of 1500 liters - 2 Nos., of 3000 liters - 2 Nos. and of 6000 liters - 1 No.
 - Dewatering Pumps of 300 liter/min - 3 Nos. and of 160 liter/min - 2 Nos.
 - Valve locator - 5 Nos.
 - Jetting Hose 13 Nos.
 - Training for 3 persons for one week.

- Technical Bids will be opened immediately after the bid submission deadline in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend, whereas the Financial Bids shall remain sealed and unopened and shall be placed locked. The Financial Bids of only Technically Responsible and Qualified Bidders shall be opened after Technical Bid Evaluation, whereas, the Financial Bids of those Bidders whose Technical Bids are not responsive and qualified shall be returned unopened after the contract is awarded. If the last date of submission and opening falls on a government holiday, the date for submission and opening of bid shall be extended the next working day.
