The Government of Nepal [GoN] has allocated funds towards the cost of Design, Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of 132 kV Purbi-Chitwan Substation and intends to apply part of the funds to cover eligible payments under the Contract named below. International Competitive Bidding (ICB) will be conducted in accordance with single stage; two envelope bidding procedure, which is open to all eligible Nepalese and Foreign Bidders.
2. The Nepal Electricity Authority (NEA, the Employer) invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for Design, Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of 132 kV Purbi-Chitwan Substation. 3. To purchase the Bidding Documents eligible bidders should:

- submit a written application along with a notarized copy of the valid firm registration certificates, VAT & PAN registration, Tax clearance certificate to the respective Project Offices requesting the Bidding Documents;
 - pay a nonrefundable fee of 20,000.00 (Twenty thousand only) Nepalese Rupees or equivalent amount by bank voucher to the NEA, East Chitwan 132 kV substation Project Current account no. 001 015 000 146 000 001 41 at the NMB Bank Ltd Babarmahal, Kathmandu or bank draft drawn in favor of the Project for above tender till February 04, 2018. The document will be handed over to the representative of the bidder upon production of the evidence of payment of the fee and above mentioned other documents. If requested, and on payment of an additional fee of NRs 5,000.00 (In words, Nepalese Rupees five thousand only) towards postal charges, the documents can be sent by courier. However, no liability will be accepted for loss or late delivery.
4. The bids will be opened in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the date and time specified above. Bids must be valid for a period of hundred twenty (120) days after bid opening and must be accompanied by a bid security or scanned copy of the bid security in PDF format in case of e-bid, amounting to a minimum of 1,40,00,000.00 NRs, which shall be valid for 30 days beyond the validity period of the bid.
 5. If the last date of purchasing and /or submission falls on a government holiday, then the next working day shall be considered as the last date. In such case the validity period of the bid security shall remain the same as specified for the original last date of bid submission.
 6. The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its bid, and NEA will in no case be responsible or liable for these costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.
 7. NEA reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder(s) or any obligation to inform the affected bidder(s) of the grounds for NEA's action.
